I hereby release, discharge, covenant not to sue, and agree to indemnify and save and hold harmless each of the releasee's from all liability claims, demands, losses, or damages on the minor's account caused or alleged to be caused, in whole or in part by the negligence of the "releasees" or otherwise, including negligent rescue operations. Assumption of the Risk and Waiver of Liability Relating to Coronavirus/COVID-19

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is believed to spread mainly from person-to-person contact. As a result, federal, state, and local governments and federal and state health agencies recommend social distancing and have, in many locations, prohibited the congregation of groups of people.

Epic Gymnastics, LLC, ("the gym") has put in place preventative measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19; however, the gym cannot guarantee that you or your child(ren) will not become infected with COVID-19. Further, attending the gym could increase your risk and your child(ren)'s risk of contracting COVID-19.

By signing this agreement, I acknowledge the contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assume the risk that my child(ren) and I may be exposed to or infected by COVID-19 by attending the gym and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, and death. I understand that the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19 at the gym may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of myself and others, including, but not limited to, gym employees, volunteers, and program participants and their families.

I voluntarily agree to assume all of the foregoing risks and accept sole responsibility for any injury to my child(ren) or myself (including, but not limited to, personal injury, disability, and death), illness, damage, loss, claim, liability, or expense, of any kind, that I or my child(ren) may experience or incur in connection with my child(ren)'s attendance at the gym or participation in gym programming ("Claims"). On my behalf, and on behalf of my children, I hereby forever release and waive my right to bring suit against Epic Gymnastics, LLC. I covenant not to sue, discharge, and hold harmless the gym, its employees, agents, and representatives, of and from the Claims, including all liabilities, claims, actions, damages, costs or expenses of any kind arising out of or relating thereto. Rules & Policies

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GENERAL RULES

- Parental observation of classes from behind our glass wall area is allowed any time.
- No Adults/non-Students allowed in main gym or mezzanine areas at any time. Children must be kept under control in the waiting area at all times. No standing on chairs or benches. Children may not go outside without direct supervision by an adult.
- No participant is allowed in the main facility (gym or mezzanine areas) or on any equipment without an EPIC Gymnastics instructor.
- No smoking permitted anywhere on the property, inside or outside. No food, drinks, gum, or parents in the gym.
- No nuts or nut products of any type are permitted in the gym. We are a nut safe zone.
- No running anywhere in the facility, unless directed to do so by your instructor.
- Participants must have instructor permission to leave the gym; this includes trips to the bathroom, water fountain, or locker room.
- Report any unusual pain or discomfort felt during participation to your instructor immediately.
- Respectful social behavior is expected of all students. Failure to act appropriately may result in removal from class and/or program.
- Arrivals & Departures require safety awareness by everyone. Be sure students are in the gym before you leave. Students must remain inside the gym until their parents arrive. Please be on time for the start & end of your class.
- Classes may be canceled, re-scheduled or combined subject to enrollment and/or instructor availability at the Gym's discretion.

Me & YOU CLASS SAFETY RULES

- All parents/caregivers participating with a child must sign a waiver/release form.
- Supervise your child at all times. Parent/caregiver is the child's instructor. Our responsibility is to coach the parent/caregiver.
- Focus on your child. If your child wanders, please follow and encourage him/her to return to the group.
- Parents must wear Sneakers in the Gym. No bare feet, sandals, or street shoes.

TRAMPOLINE & TRAINING PIT SAFETY RULES

- No student is permitted on the trampoline or training pit without an EPIC Gym instructor.
- Only one person at a time on the trampoline/in the training pit. Caregiver in Me & You class is not allowed in the training pit at any time, but must be on the edge of the pit at all times. Caregiver in Me & You class may be on the trampoline with their child for physical support, but may not bounce.
- To avoid serious injury, bounce only in the center of trampoline, never land head first on trampoline or enter training pit head first. a

REGISTRATION FORM/FEE: Registration forms must be completed and signed prior to any program participation. Registration is required each school year (9/1 – 8/31) or any part thereof. Limited secondary medical insurance is provided with a basic \$100 deductible and a one-year claim limit. Claim must be submitted within 90 days of injury. Actual coverage will be based on policy provisions in force at the time of injury.

TUITION: All classes run in four 10-week sessions during the school year, and one shorter Summer session. Payment options are as follows:

1. Pay the full four-session tuition and receive a 10% discount off your tuition. Registration is a separate fee and not included in the discount. For example, a class costing \$25/session costs \$100/year, less 10% discount of \$10, resulting in a tuition fee of \$90 for the school-year. Registration at \$5, results in a total fee of \$95 for the four sessions. This is non-refundable. In the event of illness or injury, tuition is pro-rated at the regular tuition rate and the 10% discount is invalidated. Figures in this example do not reflect actual rates.
2. Tuition may be paid each session (every 10-weeks), and families must have a valid credit/debit card on file. Students are "rolled" into the same class for the next session unless you let us know IN WRITING, two weeks prior to the charge date you are withdrawing. Cards on file will be charged two weeks prior to the start of the next session. If you do not want us to use the card on file, accounts must be settled by another method one week prior to the charge date. Upcoming charge dates will be posted in the lobby and available at the Front Desk. There are no refunds of registration, tuition, or other related fees.

RETURNED CHECKS must be paid with cash or credit card, and are subject to a \$35 handling fee.

MAKE-UPS are available for up to two missed classes per Session. Notify the gym if you will be missing a class. Missed classes will be rescheduled to a similar class during the week. You are required to schedule Make-Ups through the gym office. No "walk-ins" allowed. Make-Ups must be completed in the same Session they occur; classes missed the last week of Session may be made up at the start of the next Session. No Make-Ups may carry into Summer Session or the ensuing school year. No make ups offered during Exhibition Week.

OPEN WORK OUTS - Staff supervised sessions for registered gymnasts aged seven-18, to practice skills learned in regular gymnastics class.

LOST & FOUND- abandoned articles are donated to charity at the end of each session. We will not be responsible for lost or stolen property.

WEATHER RELATED CLOSING – Classes cancelled due to weather or circumstances beyond our control will be rescheduled.

GYM ATTIRE: Gymnastics - leotard or shorts/tights & T-shirt, hair pulled back from face, no jewelry, no bare torso, no loose clothes.
Parents – Me & You parents must wear sneakers. No bare feet, sandals, or street shoes.
Karate – Standard White Karate Uniform (Gi) with appropriate color belt.

CLASS EXHIBITIONS are held in June each school year. Students participating in the Exhibition are required to wear a "school uniform" consisting of the current class leotard, an exhibition theme leotard, or the EPIC Gym T-shirt for the year. The class leotard may be worn all year in class.

TEAM GYMNASTS have additional Rules & Policies that may be found in the current "Epic Gymnastics Competitive Team Handbook". When rules and policies conflict, the Team Handbook takes precedence.

PENDO KARATE STUDENTS: Free Sparring is not permitted without the approval and supervision of the Instructor. During Free Sparring protective headgear, mouthpieces, padded gloves, padded kicking boots and groin cups must be worn. No contact permitted to the head, face, neck or groin, except for light contact to headgear. Use of Karate -- do in or out of class for purposes of intentional abuse or harm is grounds for dismissal without refund.
